ADOPTION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG)
FY 2017-18 URBAN COUNTY ANNUAL ACTION PLAN &
AMENDMENT OF CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of Monterey County will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at 10:30 a.m. at the Monterey County Government Center, 168 W. Alisal Street, 1st Floor, Salinas, CA to consider the adoption of the Monterey Urban County FY 2017-18 Action Plan (AP) which identifies specific projects & programs that the Urban County intends to implement with CDBG funds and to amend the Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) to incorporate the Preparation of the Assessment of Fair Housing requirement into the CPP at Section B. 6.

The draft AP will be available for a 30-day Public Comment Period prior to the Public Hearing from March 31, 2017 to May 9, 2017. Public participation and/or written comments from any person, or their duly appointed representative, having an interest in the following Urban County jurisdictions are invited: the unincorporated areas of the County and the Cities of Gonzales, Greenfield, and Sand City collectively known as the “Urban County” for CDBG purposes.

The objectives and eligible CDBG Program activities to be considered in the adoption of the AP include: Public Services, Homeless Services, Affordable Housing, Public Facilities and Infrastructure projects/ programs, and Economic Development. For FY 2017, the Urban County anticipates having approximately \$1,168,660 in CDBG funds available. The proposed projects/programs and recommended funding are:
